The Klondike Challenge is a race that will be run on a timed course. The course will feature 10 stations where the Scouts will be met with different challenges. Each station will have an event that will add or subtract time from the team's total score. Complete success at each station may not ensure a team of victory, but doing poorly will ensure a longer total time. These challenges will be based on Scout Skills, ingenuity, athleticism, dexterity, and general knowledge about the BSA and America. A well blended patrol of different scouts with a variety of skills should do the best.

Camping will be available Friday and Saturday for an additional cost of \$5 per scout. Troop leaders and scouts participating in the overnight winter campout at Camp Dan Beard on February 5th 2011, have been trained in winter camping and severe weather outdoor camping skills.

1. Teams must be composed of 6 – 8 Boy Scouts, Webelos, or combination of both
(If there are a few Webelos teams they can be scored against each other.)
2. All sleds must be built by the scouts (Store bought sleds will be given a 30 min penalty)
3. The race will be run on 2 courses
4. Teams will run 1 course in the morning and run the other after lunch
5. Teams will be given a set start time (requests will be honored on a first come basis)
6. No gym shoes will be permitted
7. Dress according to the weather
