The combined time will be modified by your team's performance on each station

No Gym Shoes will be allowed (Please dress according to the weather)

Coffee, Hot Cocoa, and soup will be served free of charge

Other food concessions will be available at a small charge

**Parking is limited (Please carpool as much as possible)**

All Sleds must have runners (no wheels allowed – because otherwise it would be a cart and not a sled)

Camping is available on Friday night (\$4 per Scout extra)

## List of (Strongly) Suggested Equipment for Race

### Sled (This is needed)

50' of rope

First aid kit (patrol)

Pocket knife

Fire wood and tinder

Fire starting kit (no type of accelerant may be used)

Scout Handbook

2 gallons of water

2 blankets

(4) 6' poles for lashing

Patrol flag

1 can of non-cream soup per scout

Cup

Smaller diameter rope for lashing

Pencil

Clipboard to keep scorecard

8' x 10' tarp

Tree Identification Book/Card

Bagged Lunch or Lunch Money

## List of Stations

- **Fire building:** Build a fire and boil a cup of water the quickest. Extra points awarded for starting fire without matches. No accelerants may be used to start fire.
- **Tree Identification:** Identify 10 types of trees by bark or needle, most correct in the shortest time will win.
- **Camber Throw:** Throw a 6' log over a line suspended 12' in the air. Everyone in the patrol will get a chance. Best percentage of successful throws wins.
- **Move the Load:** Your patrol will need to move a 300lb load 50' without the use of a sled. Fastest time wins.
- **Lumber Jack Saw Mill:** Teams will use a cross cut saw to make 4 designated cuts on a log. Fastest time wins. Time will be added for inaccurate cuts.
- **Sled Pull:** Keeping 3 patrol members in the sled the remaining members must pull the sled 40', while keeping their balance standing on 4 milk crates.
- **Obstacle Course:** Patrol and sled will take on the dreaded obstacle course. Best time wins.
- **Nuclear Reactor:** Lash together a tripod. Suspend a bell on the inside and move the tripod 25' without disturbing the bell. Fastest time wins.

- **Stack the Crates:** using two poles lashed together, your patrol must stack 4 crates on top of each other from 10' away.
- **Emergency Scout Removal:** Patrol must move 4 of their (Paralyzed) Patrol Mates 50 Yards the quickest (without the sled).
